South Durham Gymnastics (SDG) are committed to making all users' experience as enjoyable as possible. South Durham Gymnastics Club (SDGC) operate from the same site as SDG. This policy is reflective of both SDG & SDGC.

Located within Spennymoor Leisure Centre, SDG has two floors. On the ground floor is the main Gymnastics Hall, two changing room facilities, an accessible toilet, 2 staff toilets, 2 offices and a staff room / kitchen area. On the first floor there is a viewing gallery, café, 2 toilets and 1 accessible toilet.

Car Parking

SDG utilise Spennymoor Leisure Centre's car park, which has 9 accessible bays. 3 of these are currently not accessible due to part of the car park being used as a compound for the Leisure Centre Transformation works; this disruption is expected to remain in place until June 2024.

There are also 3 accessible bays, solely for blue badge holders outside of the gym's fire door, which reduces the distance from parking to the gym itself. Use of these spaces / access via the club fire door needs to be arranged in advance so the gym doors can be opened on arrival.

Access to and within the Building

Entrance to both the Leisure Centre and the Gymnastics Centre fire door (utilised during bank holidays and nonstandard LC operating hours) can be accessed via slopes as well as steps.

Once inside, the floor is level – ensuring it is easy to travel across for wheelchair users / people with mobility issues.

Double doors into the facility and the Gymnastics Hall provide ample width for wheelchair users. All access doors, with the exception of those that are deemed as fire doors can be opened automatically, via code or push pad. For doors that cannot be automatically opened, a member of the SDG team will happily open these for our users / visitors.

First Floor Access

Access to the first floor can be gained via the stairs (20 steps) which has a double handrail. There is also a lift for wheelchair users / people with mobility issues / people with buggies to access the first floor Café / viewing area.

An EVAC chair is available upstairs for use by appropriately trained members of the Leisure Centre staff should an emergency evacuation need to take place (and the lift cannot be used).

Toilets & Changing Rooms

Ground Floor:

- 2 x changing rooms (1 male, 1 female)
- 1 x accessible toilet and baby changing facility
- 2 x staff toilets (1 male, 1 female)

First Floor:

- 1 x ladies toilet
- 1 x mens toilet
- 1 x accessible toilet

All toilets and changing rooms have non-slip flooring.

Assistance Dogs

Registered guide dogs are welcome at SDG. We ask that they always remain with their owner.
